## 1 *Why study in Israel?*

---

Israel can offer you quality higher education of the world's highest standard. There are a vast range of study programs for students interested in the unique opportunity of gaining a valuable qualification at the same time as undergoing the experience of a lifetime. Where else can you qualify yourself and strengthen your Jewish identity simultaneously?

Where else can you face history and discover your roots, while preparing yourself for the challenges of the future?

Add to this the relatively low cost of higher education in Israel, and the fact that new immigrants in Israel receive significant financial aid, and the question becomes: why **not** study in Israel!

## 2 *Why in English, what about my Hebrew?*

---

The language of instruction in all institutions of higher education in Israel is Hebrew. Although there is considerable advantage to native English-speakers when it comes to reading material, and often papers can be submitted in English. However there are also a number of options open to students for studying in English. But before looking at the options, let us look at the pros & cons:



**The Pros:** As an English-speaker in Israel studying in English may be the ideal solution for you, enabling the fulfillment of two dreams at once: being in Israel & getting qualified. The Israeli degrees are recognized the world over, you will meet interesting people from all over the (primarily) English-speaking world, and experience the unique opportunity to discover your Jewish roots here in Israel. You can concentrate on your studies, keep up your good grades, and not worry about tackling academic Hebrew as a student.



**The Cons:** The number of study options in English is limited, and the tuition is more expensive. As not all tuition is covered by the Student Authority, you have to pay the difference. You will find fewer opportunities to mix with Israeli students, and you are less likely to improve your Hebrew as a new student in an English speaking environment. When you finish your studies and go out into the job market you will be faced with the hurdle you have been avoiding as a student: HEBREW!

And another point to be aware of: The Student Authority does not offer assistance to students studying at branches of foreign universities in Israel, or for degrees awarded by foreign universities (even if the studies are at an Israeli Institution). Assistance is granted to most English language programs at recognized academic institutions (see list below, provided the final qualification is an Israeli one) BUT the tuition fee for programs in the English language is considerably higher than regular university fees, and the student is required to pay the difference.

**So what about your Hebrew?** If you intend to stay in Israel, you would be well advised to invest in your Hebrew studies, while you are a student, entitled to all kinds of assistance, EVEN IF you decide to study in English. Immigrant students are entitled to a LOT of help, more than the regular 5 month ulpan allocated to every new immigrant. There are various ulpanim and pre-academic programs run by the Student Authority in conjunction with the academic institutions. You are advised to check which program would suit your specific needs.



## Who helps immigrant students?

The Student Authority helps new immigrants, Returning Minors and "Citizens Born Abroad", who study in recognized institutions of higher education in Israel. We are a joint partnership between the Ministry of Absorption and the Jewish Agency. Our aim is to provide the new immigrant student with information on studies in Israel, to give advice and guidance on suitable absorption and study tracks, to assist with tuition fees of up to 3 years, tutoring and individual aid and to initiate social and cultural events.

The Student Authority provides assistance for undergraduate & graduate degrees. The Student Authority also provides assistance for: Teaching Certificates, Practical Engineering, Certification in Nursing & Para-Medical Professions and Certification in the Arts

The Student Authority assists students studying in institutions or courses of study recognized by The Council for Higher Education, The Ministry of Health, The Ministry of Education and The National Institute of Technology.



## What about tourists?

If you want to come to Israel as a tourist there are many options for short or long term programs, academic study programs or experiential programs, for many of which you may be able to receive subsidy from the Jewish Agency. The Student Authority does not assist student tourists.

If you decide to study in English here are your options:

Academic Programs in Israel in English - Fees & Student Authority participation are correct to November 2008 and may change.

Student Authority participation will be up to standard fees as published by the council for higher education in Israel.

As of Nov. 2008 up to 9200 NIS for an Undergraduate degree (B.A., B.Sc, LLB, B.Ed ect.) and up to 12200 NIS for a Graduate degree (M.A., M.Sc., LLM, M.Ed ect.)

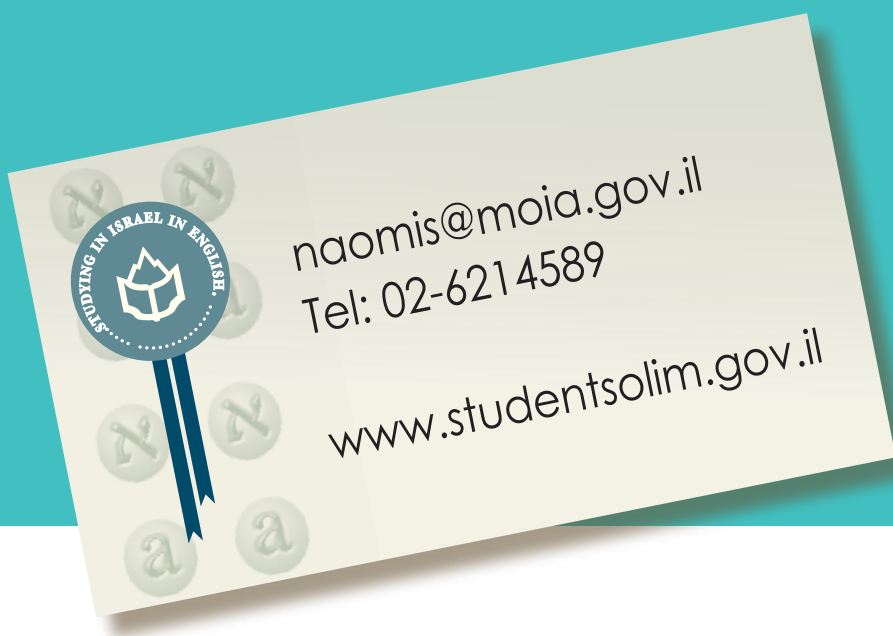
